STEP 1: Assessment

STEP 3: Controlled and Communicative Exercises

Exercise 1. You and your tutor are going to verify the list of ingredients on your favorite cosmetic on the YUCA app.

- Discuss which product you would both like to analyse and why.
- Download the free application on your phone. If you have a cosmetic product, you can scan it. The application will give a grade on 100 for the product.
- Look at the results for your product and discuss if it is safe or not. Would you buy it again? Explain your answer.

Exercise 2. You are now going to verify if your favourite cosmetic has been tested on animals.

- Go to Beauty without Bunnies or download the app.
- Search for your favourite cosmetic. Has it been tested on animals? Would you buy it again? Explain your answer.

STEP 4: Production Task

Discuss these questions with your tutor. Explain your position for each one.

- 1. What are the advantages and disadvantages of knowing the ingredients inside a cosmetic product?
- 2. Are you going to test your cosmetics with the Yuka app from now on? Why or why not?
- 3. In the future, before buying new cosmetics will you check to see if they have been tested on animals?
- 4. Is there another app or website that you already use for testing your products? Which one?
