Example: I won't have children. Will you have children?


- The second player, then, marks an "O" and follows the same instructions.



TIP

Will **Be Going To**

a. Prediction

Example: It will be sunny tomorrow.

a. Prediction

Example: It is going to be sunny tomorrow.

b. Indicates something that was not planned.

b. Indicates a plan.

Example: A: I don't understand my math homework.

B: I am going to study for my exam.

B: Don't worry. I will help you.

("B" had plans before "A" asked the question.)

Example: A: Why did you come home early?

("B" had no plans to help "A.")
